## DESIGN FOR A FONT OF TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,396, dated April 11, 1905.

Application filed March 15, 1905. Serial No. 250,285. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILL BRADLEY, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Concord, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Font of Type, of which the following is a specification.

This design is shown in the accompanying drawing, in which it will be seen that the font comprises a set of capitals, small letters, numerals, the character "and," the dollar-mark,

the pound-sterling mark, the usual marks of punctuation, together with the paragraph-mark, characters representing ct, qu, tt, st, and ornaments.

What I claim is—
